

## Light Line, 2nd Avenue

The first light component out of several, for 2nd avenue projects

### 1st. STAGE

A continuous Fiber Optic forming a **Light Line** moving predominantly horizontally from building to building, on both sides of the street, four blocks long. Starting at N. 3rd. St. and ending at S. 1st. St.

Each building picks the **Light Line** off where the previous building left it, at approximately 10 ft of the sidewalk in height. Each building runs the line across the facade at will, enhancing any desirable contour, and ending approximately 10 ft above the sidewalk. Each building pays their own portion depending on amount of linear feet utilized. (cost listing available) Most Fiber Optics are limited to 100 lft per lamp.

This first stage will provide a **Light Trail** from the public parking structure to Gusman Center and will be most visible and striking to vehicular traffic coming South on Second Ave. This light trail will also provide a direct linear connection between parking and performance nights at Gusman for pedestrian traffic late at night.

This **Light Line** concept reinforces other projects such as the sidewalk improvement project and color change project.

A second stage will incorporate an extension of the **Light Line** north and South

A third stage could incorporate a vertical component on tall buildings, specifically 701 Brickell Barnett Bank.
