Miami's signature skyline will be aglow in memory of Mother Teresa's 100 year Anniversary on August 26th, 2010. Leading downtown buildings will display blue and white lights, the color of the Missionaries of Charity Sisters, while one hundred plus buildings will extend their lights past 11:00PM.

In recognition of a unique human soul who promoted love and peace throughout the world and as a tribute to the power of the individual to pursue kindheartedness and compassion for all, the skyline community will light up in a voluntary effort to call attention to the energy earmarked towards the concern for the hungry, the sick, the poor and the forgotten dying without dignity and love.

The Missionary of Charity Sisters have a center in Miami at 727 NW 17th St. from which they carry on the mission of Mother Teresa "We are created for greater things, to love and be loved," one place where the symbolism of the light-up is actualized in a daily basis.

Other cities will also have blue and white illuminated structures in commemoration of Mother Teresa, such as the Peace Bridge spanning the Niagara River from Buffalo to Fort Erie. The Benedictine College, Atchison Kansas. Brooklyn Borough Hall in NY. Also the U.S. Postal Service is honoring Mother Teresa with a commemorative stamp on September 5th.

Several suggested locations for a view or film of the skyline on the 25th and 26th are: Port of Miami SW edge, Watson Island, Jungle Island (Parrot Jungle) building, and high up in one of the Omni area buildings such as the Marriot Hotel.
